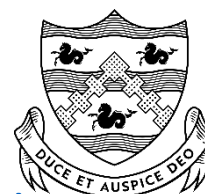

<p>The kinds of Special Education Needs and Disabilities which are provided for at Beaminster School</p>	<p>Beaminster School recognises that students with special educational needs may fall into one or more of the following four categories:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Communication and Interaction• Cognition and Learning• Social, Emotional and Mental Health difficulties• Sensory and/or physical needs
<p>How Beaminster School identifies and assesses young people with SEND</p>	<p>Young people with SEND are identified and assessed by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Information passed on from primary schools• Whole school literacy screening in Year 7 and Year 9• Individual assessments for access arrangements• Teacher referrals• TA referrals• Parent referrals• Student referrals
