Sixth Form Induction Programme Monday 27th – Wednesday 29th June

With students' time in Year 11 drawing to a close, our attention turns to preparing students for their next steps.

The Joint Sixth Form are running a three-day 'next steps and Sixth Form induction programme' from **Monday 27th June to Wednesday 29th June**. All students joining the Joint Sixth Form in September are expected to attend, but an **offer is extended to all current Year 11 students to attend on Monday 27th as part of our post-16 transition support**.

Students joining the Yeovil College Partnership as part of the Joint Sixth Form, or those interested in finding out more about the Partnership, should attend on Monday 27th June.

Students should arrive and depart from their home school site. All activities will be completed within the school day and any travel between the sites will be provided. School uniform is not expected and please be aware that Monday afternoon activities are outside, so be prepared for any type of weather! Lunch is provided for all students on Monday but students are asked to provide their own lunch on Tuesday and Wednesday. Students will need a notebook and writing equipment with them each day.

On Tuesday and Wednesday students will have introductory lessons for their chosen options. Staff will introduce the course and outline the summer bridging tasks, which should be completed ahead of students returning in September. The majority of students have chosen three subjects and an individual timetable will be provided.

When at the 'other' site, students will also be given a tour of the school and set up with an email account and guidance on how to use the new systems.
