### Academic Monitoring Day – Friday 11<sup>th</sup> November

In line with the rest of the school, Sixth Form students will participate in Academic Monitoring Day on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> November.

During the day all students will have a 15-minute one-to-one interview at an agreed time with their Tutor in their usual tutor base (unless other arrangements have been made).

Tutors and students will review progress, identify goals to be achieved over the coming year and discuss ways the students can reach these goals. Tutors will be able to provide support and guidance based on information they have already gathered.

There will be no formal lessons running on this day and students are only required to be in school for their appointment. Students in Year 13 though do have a number of deadlines approaching and I would therefore encourage them to spend the day in school.

The Sixth Form study room will be available and staffed throughout the day. In particular I would encourage students to attend if they:

- have NEA/coursework to complete
- are completing an EPQ
- need to complete a personal statement for university applications
- are behind due to absence.

Students will be asked to sign in/out as they arrive/leave the site.
