"An Introduction to the Legal System" in association with the UK Supreme Court

The Introduction to the Legal System programme gives students a chance to look at a case which was recently heard in the Supreme Court. Participants will review the decision made by the court, before coming to their own conclusions and writing a report.

The project also gives the participants the opportunity to learn about the work of the Supreme Court - the highest court in England and Wales - and to engage with cutting edge legal policy, while at the same time learning about the role of our legal system more broadly.

The schedule for the 2026 project is as follows:

- Thursday 21 May, 6.30-8.30pm via Zoom: An introductory lecture, explaining the basics of the English Legal System
- Thurs 28 May, 6.30-8.30pm via Zoom: A lecture on the relevant areas of law
- Thursday 4 June, 6.30-8.30pm via Zoom: A panel talk by the legal professionals providing insight into the Supreme Court case
- Thursday 11 June, 6.30-8.30pm via Zoom: A workshop to test the students' knowledge and report writing session
- Thursday 18 June, 6.30-8.30pm via Zoom: Further report writing session
- Saturday 27 June, 11pm: Deadline to submit report
- Thursday 9 July, 6.30-8.30pm via Zoom: Speech preparation session ahead of final event
- Tuesday 21 July, 5.00-7.00pm: **Final event at the UK Supreme Court in London.** The best three students will present their thoughts about the case to a panel of legal professionals.

Apply now:

The only eligibility requirements we have are that you will be 16 years or over at the time of the project and that you are studying for your A-Levels (or equivalent) at a non-fee paying school.

All of our projects are free of charge for all students. Travel and accommodation expenses will be paid for students travelling from outside of London.
