She will help you if you ever feel unwell at school




SEN Teacher Miss Clifford

You will see her in the office and she will help you if get lost or need advice




This is our Bus Park

This is our Sports Hall which is close to the bus park




The Main School Courtyard

The Main School Field In Summer, Years 7 and 8 use the left hand side of the trees Years 9, 10 and 11 use the right hand side






This is our main school Hall You will have assemblies in here and attend concerts and

A Computer Room








This is the outside of the Canteen where you will queue to go in
