Dear 6th Form Student,

6th Form Bursary

You are invited to make an application for a 6th Form Bursary. Applications will be reviewed at three points during the academic year. In order to be considered for a bursary an application must be received by the respective deadline. You are able to apply at more than one point throughout the year, allowing you a more accurate picture of costs involved.

All completed application forms must be handed in to school Reception (**marked 16-19 Bursary**). The deadlines for the academic year 2024-2025 are:

- Friday 27th September 2024
- Friday 24th January 2025
- Friday 16th May 2025.

You must be under 19 on 31st August in the academic year you start your programme of study. There are two types of Bursary:

Type 1

Are you eligible?

If you are in one of the groups below, you can apply for a vulnerable bursary:

- in care
- care leaver
- getting [Income Support](#) or [Universal Credit](#) in place of Income Support in your own name
- getting [Employment Support Allowance](#) (or Universal Credit in place of ESA) and Disability Living Allowance or [Personal Independence Payments](#) in your own name.

You could get up to £1,200 if you study full time for a minimum of 30 weeks. If your course is only for less than 30 weeks, you will get less.

Type 2

Students who are in a household with an annual income below £29,000, or who are in receipt, or have been in receipt of free school meals within the last three years, are invited to apply for a discretionary bursary. Please see Bursary Information sheet for the types of things for which you can apply for assistance.

Please note that other conditions apply, see school website document "Sixth Form Bursary Fund"
