As we head towards the Easter Break, I am writing with regards to the forthcoming GCSE examinations and planned activities to mark the end of Year 11s' time at Beaminster School.

Students approached their mocks with calmness, a real sense of maturity and demonstrated excellent exam routines.

Students should soon have their **Leavers' hoodies** and may wear them until the GCSE examinations start on Monday 15th May 2023. Please note that hoodies are <u>not</u> permitted in examination rooms, students must wear their full school uniform. May we also remind you that students MUST have a **completely clear pencil case** for their exams and a **clear drinks bottle**, no coloured Chilly type bottles are permitted, and bottles should only contain water, no other liquids. A checklist is attached for information, and further guidance can also be found on the Exams pages of the school website.

All students must remain in school for lessons until Friday 26th May 2023 and must also <u>remain available</u> up to and including Wednesday 28th June 2023 for the exam contingency day.

GCSE Results Day is Thursday 24th August 2023, which is when students are notified of their results.

Formal **exam cerificates**, which provide proof of the qualifications gained for future employers, will be available to collect from school from November 2023. **Please ensure students remember to collect these certificates**, they are important documents that colleges and employers will ask to see and cannot be easily replaced!

Any **Revision Guides** that students no longer need will be very gratefully received as they can be used again to help other students in future. Please feel free to drop any unwanted Revison Guides at Reception, or bring them in on GSCE Results Day in August.
