Dear Year 11 Parents and Carers

With just over 11 school weeks before their GCSE Examinations, I am writing to let you know of the planned arrangements for our Year 11 students, to celebrate their successes and achievements during their time at Beaminster School. Please put these dates in your diaries:

Celebration Day and Meal	...	Friday 22 nd May 2026
Yearbook	...	Handed out on Celebration Day
Year 11 Prom	...	Monday 22 nd June 2026 evening

In addition to the above, the **Class of 2026 Hoodie** will be available to purchase on-line from our uniform supplier, Kitz for £22. Please see the separate letter regarding hoodies. Consent must be given for names to appear on the reverse of the hoodie.

Celebration Day is on Friday 22nd May 2026.

Students taking their PE exam in the morning will be given separate rooms in order to change and get dressed. All other students should arrive at school for 11:30am, dressed in all their finery. Please remember that students need to be suitably dressed as this is normal school day for the rest of the school.

Once costs have been confirmed, a detailed letter will be sent out and the items (with the exception of the hoodie) will appear on ParentMail to purchase.

All students must remain at school until Friday 15th May 2026.

Students must attend school and stay in lessons until this date. Studying and revision at home is not permitted. All revision will be done in school, to maximise revision potential.

All students MUST be also available up to and including Wednesday 24th June 2026 for the national exam contingency day.

GCSE Results Day is Thursday 20th August 2026 and students will then be able to collect their exam certificates from November 2026.

I hope this letter explains arrangements for the end of Year 11 and will enable students to be fully focussed on their mock examinations and studies.
