Dear Year 12 and 13 Parents and Carers

Dorset and Wiltshire Fire and Rescue Service (DWFRS) will be visiting us on Tuesday 10th February to deliver a Young Driver and Passenger Education session for all students in our 6th Form.

This session aims to provide students with the information, advice and practical tips they need to stay safer on the roads, whether as a driver (now or in the future) or as a passenger.

Our objective is to equip your young person with the tools and knowledge to enable positive and safe choices as they become independent adults on the road.

The session will be delivered by a member of the DWFRS road safety team and is a mixture of film clips, interactive tasks, and discussion. The lesson is designed to avoid upset or worry, however, if your child has been involved in, or been affected by, a road traffic collision at any point in time, you are welcome to contact us to discuss.

We would appreciate your support in:

- encouraging them to attend the session.
- encouraging them to sign up to the free year's worth of road safety emails.
- remembering your young person will be observing your driving habits as they take this next step in their independence. They will pick up on and likely copy your behaviour so try to always keep calm and focused.
