#### **Dear Parents and Carers**

It has been a busy week for our **GCSE students** with Year 10 receiving their mid-year reports on Thursday and Year 11 Parents' Evening on Wednesday. After another excellent half-term of **House Sports competition**, it was Lewesdon who won the girls football last Friday and Eggardon who took the boys badminton. **Lewesdon** have now extended their lead over Eggardon to five points, but with much to play for in the second half of the year.

At the **Year 7 Netball** tournament at Budmouth on Tuesday the team played brilliantly, and successfully worked their way through several rounds to reach the final. After a riveting match they eventually lost 6-3. The Year 7 and 8 girls **Hockey team** then played their first competitive match against Colfox on Thursday, showing great determination and skill but sadly losing 5-2 after conceding two early goals. Well done to them all.
