A Level Induction Update – Important Change

We would like to inform you of an important update regarding the A Level Induction programme taking place in a couple of weeks.

Following careful consideration, we have decided to consolidate the induction process into **one full day which will be Friday 19th June 2026**.

We believe this revised format will provide students with a more focused and engaging introduction to Sixth Form life and their new studies.

During the induction day, students will have the opportunity to:

- Attend an introductory presentation about A Level study, including the enrichment options that we offer and an outline of Sixth Form expectations.
- Meet their new classmates and begin building friendships.
- Experience both of our school sites, including Sixth Form Common Rooms and study facilities.
- Take part in a session for **each of their chosen A Level courses**, giving them a valuable insight into what to expect in September
- Gather together important “Summer Bridging Tasks” from each subject, which provide tasks designed to help you start your courses strongly in September.

We will be spending the morning at Colfox and return to Beaminster for the afternoon. Students can therefore either bring a packed lunch and drink or use the canteen at Beaminster. Snacks will be provided at Colfox at break time, and also at the end of the day at Beaminster.

We will be using the Link Bus to travel to Colfox **promptly at 8.40am** from the bus park. If students arrive earlier, please come to the Sixth Form Common Room to meet friends and collect your timetable.

Activities will be completed within the school day and any travel between the sites will be provided. School uniform is not expected, but clothing should be appropriate for a working day, and students will need to have a notebook and writing equipment with them.
