The Château's extensive grounds provide the perfect environment for students to improve their language skills and confidence, through a range of on-site activities all taught in French by native-speaking animateurs. 


your child to take part. They will need to bring in a bicycle on the training day, if students do not have a bike to bring in please advise Mrs Stone.


