This week has certainly provided a rich range of exciting activities, with staff and students busy across all year groups.

It was a real pleasure to welcome back a large **Year 11 cohort**, looking much rested a week after their final examinations, as they were prepared for 6th form in September with two days of induction. This was then followed, on Thursday, with Year 11s enjoying a day out to Thorpe Park with Tutors.

Our **School Open Evening** on Wednesday kept everyone on their toes as over 100 sets of parents / carers came to visit us from over 30 different schools. The opportunity to tour our attractive site at their leisure and speak to subject staff made this a very affable evening. My particular thanks to the many students who came along for the evening and were exemplary representatives.

The bespoke training at the Lyme Regis **Boat Building Academy and Furniture School** has proved to be an inspiration for over twenty of our Year 10 and Sixth Form technology students. During an intensive day, students were given an in-depth tour of the facilities, and through the educational workshops developed skills that they were then able to apply to produce some beautifully crafted wooden mallets.

Our Key Stage 3 **SustainAbleYou** team had a fantastic day at the South West Sustainable Transport Challenge at Bath University on Monday. After a very confident presentation on their design and ideas, they had a tour of the facilities and heard about the many opportunities available in the engineering and environmental sectors.

Reading Week, for Key Stage 3, had our students looking at morphology and the study of words.
