Year 12 UCAS Discovery Day, Exeter (Weds 22nd March) and Mock Exam Information

Reminder

All Year 12 students are participating in the UCAS Discovery Day in Exeter tomorrow (Wednesday 22nd March). All students should have registered for this event and payment is required via ParentMail +Pay.

Advance Notice

Year 12 students will be sitting mock exams in (almost) all subjects between Tuesday 18th and Thursday 20th April. Students are not expected to attend lessons during this time, lessons will recommence on Thursday afternoon. The exams timetable is on display in the Sixth Form area and a copy is attached. All exams will take place on the Beaminster site (other than the Art exam which will take place at Colfox in the usual room), with morning exams starting at 9am and afternoon exams starting at 1pm.

For students taking Maths in Context (Core Maths) this is the final mock exam before the 'real thing'.

Teaching staff will be informing students about the topics to be examined and providing some lesson time for revision. It is important, however, that students also revise independently for these exams. The mock exams provide a useful indicator of students' progress, which will help to inform discussions about next steps. They also provide information on areas for development and valuable practise in completing work under timed conditions.

Results from the mock exams, and other information, will be shared with parents via a full report on 23rd May.
