Dear Year 10 Parents, Carers and Students,

Year 10 Post-16 Yeovil College Taster Day, Tuesday 4th July

Students will be taking part in a Careers Taster Day at Yeovil College on Tuesday 4th July.

This event will help students discover more about further education options available after GCSEs at Yeovil College.

Students have already chosen some subject-specific workshops and will gain experience of vocational courses that might be available to them. These courses range from Level 1 to Level 2 learning.

Students should register as normal in the morning and will then travel to Yeovil by bus from Beaminster, leaving promptly at 9am and returning before 3.30pm.

School uniform is not required, but students will **need to either bring a packed lunch and a drink** (students eligible for Free School Meals will be provided with a packed lunch), or money to buy food from the canteen at Yeovil.


