Dear Sixth Form Parents, Carers and Students

Progress Reports and Academic Monitoring Day for Sixth Form Students Thursday 20th November 2025

Sixth Form students will be bringing home today their first Progress Report of the academic year to share with you. These have just been handed out and discussed during our weekly Tutor Period, providing a snap-shot of attitude and achievement at this early point in the year.

Sixth Form Tutors have been meeting individually with their tutees once a fortnight. In addition, Academic Monitoring Day on <u>Thursday 20th November 2025</u> has been set aside to carry out a more formal meeting. Most students have now confirmed their meeting times. Feedback from previous years suggests that your attendance is incredibly valuable and so we would ask parents and carers to attend where possible.

During the day all students will have a 15 minute one-to-one interview at an agreed time with their Tutors in their usual tutor bases (unless other arrangements have been made). Tutors and students will review progress, identify goals to be achieved over the coming year and discuss ways the students can reach their full potential and access a career path of their choosing. Progress Reports can also be reviewed during the meeting.

On the day, usual lessons will <u>not</u> be running for Beaminster students, so they only need to be in school for the time of their interview. However, the Sixth Form Study Room will be open for any Sixth Form students wanting to work in school.

All students must **sign in at the Hall on arrival**, and must also sign out from the Hall when leaving, for fire regulation purposes. A limited canteen service will be provided and normal school transport will be running.

In addition, we have a Staff Training Day this Friday, so no lessons will take place for Beaminster students who should use the day to work at home independently.

There will be a workshop running on both Thursday and Friday for Year 13 Psychology students, our thanks to Mrs Perkins for organising this useful event.
