Dear Parents and Carers

A Level Geography Field Trip to Bristol, Tuesday 7th March 2023

I am pleased to be able to offer a field trip day to Bristol to our Year 12 and 13 A Level Geography students.

The purpose of this visit is to fulfil the requirement for students to participate in field trips as part of their A Level Geography course, as well as providing a case study of a changing city to support the Human Geography element of the course. We will be studying various parts of Bristol, but spending the majority of our time around the regenerated Bristol Docks.

As well as studying Bristol's urban characteristics and change, we will also be carrying out primary data collection, including land use mapping and environmental quality surveys. Part of our itinerary will include times where students will be working in a small group collecting data independently. Good, safe behaviour is essential in this urban, waterside location.

We will travel by coach to Bristol leaving the Sir John Colfox site at 8am, then the Beaminster School Bus Park at 8.15am. We will be returning to Beaminster and then Colfox for 3.30pm.

To ensure the smooth running of the day, students need to be prepared by bringing:

- 1. A packed lunch for the day, including plenty of drinking water.
- 2. A small amount of money to purchase drinks/snacks is optional.
- 3. Writing equipment essential and a clipboard if possible.
- 4. Medication e.g. asthma inhaler etc, please give specific details on the consent form.
- 5. A warm, waterproof coat to wear in case it rains and flat, sensible footwear as we will be outside for most of the day.

In order for this field trip to go ahead we are asking for a contribution of **£22.00** per person, to cover transport. Payment should be made through ParentMail +*Pay* by **Wednesday 1**st **March** 2023, a payment item for this will be available shortly. Should you have any concerns about payment, please contact your Head of Sixth Form for information about bursaries and other financial assistance available for post-16 students at Beaminster and The Sir John Colfox Academy.
