Dear Parents and Carers

The arrival of the clear, blue skies has been welcomed by many after the horrendous rainfall over the past few months. However, it proved to be very challenging conditions high up on the Budmouth **Cross Country** route with the icy cold and cutting wind coming straight off the sea.

Despite this, our Junior Boys continued their winning ways by taking race 3 of the **South West Dorset Championship** competing against eight other schools. Individually, Joe Whelan was 1st with Henry Guppy 4th, Ben Keeping 6th and Harley Shaw 10th. Additionally, in the Junior Girls, Anna Bibby came 4th to round off a really successful Cross Country season; well done to all 30 of our runners.

Meanwhile, our **Year 8 and 9 Hockey players** also showed great progress holding two experienced teams to 3-3, before losing out in the final few minutes. The **Year 8 Basketball** team continue to shine with a strong win over the Year 8 All Saints teams, 25 - 6 and then a very intense, physical 16 - 14 victory over their Year 9 team.
